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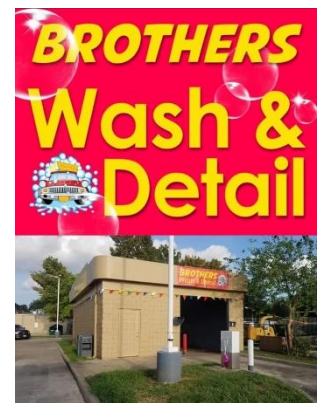


New Chop Shop

Bits & Pieces



- Site work has started for the new Spec's Liquor location in La Porte, which is on Fairmont near Farrington St. The store is expected to be open by summer 2021.
- Vega's Mexican Restaurant has closed at 3709 Center Street.
- Port Houston just had its busiest month ever, jumping up 15% over October 2019 by handling over 296,000 twenty-foot-equivalent (TEU) container units, putting it year-to-date at only 1% lower than 2019 (which was a record year for Port Houston). October's operating revenue also set a new record at \$36.6 million.
- The phone on the International Space Station has a Houston (281) area code. You cannot call the ISS, but astronauts can make outgoing calls. The phone is used when the astronauts make calls to Earth, and the incoming phone number shows up with a 281 area code.
