Silent Witness Voluntary Surveillance Camera Registration Program



The Deer Park Police Department is committed to providing excellent service to our citizens; to be effective, we must use every available method at our disposal to deter and/or solve crime. One of the most effective methods is video surveillance, and we are discovering that more and more of our residents are utilizing video surveillance systems on the exterior of their homes.

With our recent successes in solving crimes by placing suspect photos on our Facebook page, the Deer Park Police Department is initiating a program called "Silent Witness" where citizens can register their exterior facing cameras with the police department in an effort to assist in solving crimes. When a crime occurs in the vicinity of a residence that has a registered camera, the Investigator will make contact with the owner and ask to view their video in an attempt to identify the suspect. Knowledge of cameras in and around the city would save us valuable time during investigations and could help in apprehending offenders. The program is entirely voluntary and consent to view video footage from your camera could be withdrawn at any time.
