

ORDINANCE NO. 4387

AN ORDINANCE CALLING A GENERAL ELECTION IN THE CITY OF DEER PARK, TEXAS, ON MAY 6, 2023, FOR THE ELECTION OF MAYOR AND THREE COUNCILMEMBERS, POSITIONS ONE, TWO AND THREE; ESTABLISHING THE ELECTION PRECINCT FOR SUCH ELECTION; THE POLLING PLACE THEREFOR; NAMING THE ELECTION JUDGES AND PROVIDING FOR THEIR COMPENSATION; NAMING ELECTION STAFF; AND PROVIDING FOR NOTICE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DEER PARK:

1. An election shall be held in the City of Deer Park, Texas, on May 6, 2023, between the hours of 7:00 o'clock a.m. and 7:00 p.m. for the purpose of electing the following Officers to said City:

**MAYOR
COUNCILMEMBER, POSITION 1
COUNCILMEMBER, POSITION 2
COUNCILMEMBER, POSITION 3**

Said election shall be conducted using the E-Slate Machine.

2. The boundary lines of each Voting Precinct are hereby established for voting in the aforesaid election as per Ordinance No. 3068 of the City of Deer Park, adopted February 7, 2006.

3. The voting and polling place in the precinct for such election for all qualified voters living therein shall be at the following place in said City:

6. The following persons are hereby appointed as Central Counting Station Personnel for the election:

7. The City Secretary is hereby directed and instructed to post notice of election as prescribed by the Texas Election Law, Sec. 4.003 and Sec. 4.004 and the City of Deer Park, Section 3.05. Said notices shall be posted at least twenty-one (21) days before the date of said election, and shall be published in the official city newspaper once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks, such publication to be no earlier than thirty (30) days before such election date and no later than ten (10) days before such election date).

8. The Presiding Judge is hereby authorized to appoint two (2) Clerks to assist in conducting said election, and as many more as she deems necessary for the proper conduct of such election, up to a maximum of six (6). The Presiding Judge shall receive eighteen and no/100 dollars (\$18.00) per hour for their services. The Alternate Judge shall receive seventeen and no/100 dollars (\$17.00) per hour for their services. The Clerk shall receive sixteen and no/100 dollars (\$16.00) per hour for their services. Neither Judges nor Clerks shall be paid more than one (1) hour before the opening of the Polls, nor more than two (2) hours after the closing of the Polls. The Judge or Clerk who delivers the returns of election shall be paid an amount not to exceed twenty-five and no/100 dollars (\$25.00) for that service; provided, also, she shall make returns of the election. All of the aforesaid compensation shall be paid from the General Fund of the City.

9. The mailing address to which ballot applications and ballots voted by mail for City of Deer Park is – Angela Smith, Early Voting Clerk, City of Deer Park, P.O. Box 700, Deer Park, TX 77536

and physical address is City Hall, 710 E. San Augustine, Deer Park TX 77536.. The early voting clerk, in Accordance with the provisions of the Texas Election Code, shall maintain a roster listing of each person who votes by personal appearance and each person to whom a ballot to be voted by mail is sent.

In accordance with Article VIII, Section 1 of the City Charter, this Ordinance was introduced before the City Council of the City of Deer Park, Texas, **passed, approved and adopted** on this the 17th day of January, 2023 by a vote of 7 "Ayes" and 0 "Noes".




